

FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR PROVISION OF SERVICES

AS Creditinfo Eesti („the Contractor“) (registry code 10256137, seated at Tatari st 1, 10116 Tallinn) in the person of member of the management board Elari Tammenuurm, on one side, and

_____ („the Contracting Entity“) (registry code _____, seated at _____) in the person of member of the management board _____, on the other side (the Contractor and the Contracting Entity are also mentioned in the Contract separately as “the Party” and together as “the Parties”), have entered into this contract („the Contract“) on __.__.20__ as follows:

- 1. Object of the Contract.** Pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Contract, the Contracting Entity becomes entitled to order data on legal and natural persons from the “E-Krediidiinfo” database, owned by the Contractor. Upon the performance of the Contract, the Contracting Entity undertakes to follow all conditions established and instructions issued by the Contractor.
- 2. Making inquiries.** To receive data from the “E-Krediidiinfo” database, the Contracting Entity identifies itself upon logging onto the “E-Krediidiinfo” system by means of the username and password issued to the Contracting Entity, ID-card or another means of personal identification. The Contracting Entity is responsible for not disclosing the username, password and other means of personal identification to any third parties and for using them lawfully, whereas all inquiries made by using the username and password or other means of personal identification of the Contracting Entity shall be deemed made by the Contracting Entity. Even if the username and password or other means of personal identification of the Contracting Entity have been used unlawfully, the Contracting Entity shall be deemed responsible for the obligations associated with such inquiry (including compensation for damages). Inquiries of data of natural persons are permitted only upon legitimate interest.
- 3. Fee.** The Contracting Entity undertakes to pay a fee to the Contractor for the performance of the Contract in accordance with the price list and invoices of the Contractor. The Contractor has the right to unilaterally amend the price list by giving the Contracting Entity a respective notice at least 14 days in advance (hereinafter referred to as: advance notice term). If the Contracting Entity does not agree with the amendment then the Contracting Entity is entitled to cancel the Contract during the advance notice term by notifying the Contractor respectively in a format which can be reproduced in writing. Upon expiry of the advance notice term the Contracting Entity loses its right to cancel the Contract based on grounds established in this clause.
- 4. Data protection.** The Contracting Entity gives its consent to the Contractor to process its personal data (including the personal data of members of the management board) in the extent required for the performance of the Contract and provision of the service described in the Contract. If the Contracting Entity breaches the Contract then the Contractor becomes entitled to publish the data of the Contracting Entity’s payment defaults in the “Credit Register”.
- 5. Validity of the Contract.** The Contract enters into force at the moment of its signing by representatives of the Parties and it is entered into for an unspecified period of time. The General Service Conditions of AS Creditinfo Eesti (available at <https://www.creditinfo.ee/en/about-us/general-terms-and-conditions/>) and the instructions of the Contractor constitute integral parts of the Contract and the Contracting Entity confirms having reviewed these documents prior to entry into the Contract. The Parties have the right to ordinarily cancel the Contract by giving the respective notice to the other Party at least 14 days in advance. The Contractor has the right to cancel the Contract without following the advance notice term (extraordinarily) if the Contracting Entity submits incorrect data, violates the payment obligation or copyright of the Contractor or fails to use the services in accordance with their intended purpose.
